END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR SCOM 2012 MAINTENANCE MODE SCHEDULER SOFTWARE

IMPORTANT—READ CAREFULLY: This End-User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you (a single entity) and SCOM2K7 for the SCOM 2012 Maintenance Mode Scheduler software that accompanies this EULA, which includes associated media and SCOM2K7 software services ("Software"). An amendment or addendum to this EULA may accompany the Software. YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS EULA BY INSTALLING, COPYING, OR USING THE SOFTWARE. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE, DO NOT INSTALL, COPY, OR USE THE SOFTWARE.

- 1. GRANT OF LICENSE. SCOM2K7 grants you the following rights provided that you comply with all terms and conditions of this EULA:
- 1.1 Installation and use

Unlimited Site License:

If you are using the Software under the control of a Site License, you may:

- (a) Install the Software on an unlimited number of computers at single Organization at all locations (offices, branches, sites).
- (b) Use the Software by an unlimited number of concurrent users as long as each user is employed by a single Organization and working at one of the official offices/branches.

Registration:

If Licensee purchases the License directly from SCOM2K7, registration is automatic.

You agree that SCOM2K7 may audit your use of the Software for compliance with these terms at any time, upon reasonable notice. In the event such audit reveals any use of the Software by you other than in full compliance with the terms of this Agreement, you shall reimburse SCOM2K7 for all reasonable expenses related to such audit in addition to any liabilities you may occur as a result of such non-compliance.

- 2. DESCRIPTION OF OTHER RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS
- 2.1 Software Activation.

SOME SOFTWARE PRODUCTS MAY INCLUDE TECHNOLOGICAL MEASURES THAT ARE DESIGNED TO PREVENT UNLICENSED USE OF THE SOFTWARE. You may not be able to exercise your rights to the Software under this EULA after a finite number of product launches unless you activate your copy of the Software in the manner described during the launch sequence. You may also need to reactivate the Software if you modify your computer hardware or alter the Software. SCOM2K7 will use those measures to confirm you have a legally licensed copy of the Software. If you are not using a licensed copy of the Software, you are not allowed to install the Software or future Software updates. SCOM2K7 will not collect any personally identifiable information from your device during this process.

- 3. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS AND OWNERSHIP. SCOM2K7 reserves all rights not expressly granted to you in this EULA. The Software is protected by copyright and other intellectual property laws and treaties. SCOM2K7 or its suppliers own the title, copyright, and other intellectual property rights in the Software. The Software is licensed, not sold. This EULA does not grant you any rights to trademarks or service marks of SCOM2K7.
- 4. LIMITATIONS ON REVERSE ENGINEERING, DECOMPILATION, AND DISASSEMBLY. You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software, except and only to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this limitation.
- 5. CONSENT TO USE OF DATA. You agree that SCOM2K7 and its affiliates may collect and use technical information gathered as part of the product support services provided to you, if any, related to the Software.
- SCOM2K7 may use this information solely to improve our products or to provide customized services or technologies to you and will not disclose this information in a form that personally identifies you.
- 8. ADDITIONAL SOFTWARE/SERVICES. This EULA applies to updates, supplements, add-on components, or Internet-based services components, of the Software that SCOM2K7 may provide to you or make available to you after the date you obtain your initial copy of the Software, unless they are accompanied by separate terms.
- SCOM2K7 reserves the right to discontinue Internet-based services provided to you or made available to you through the use of the Software.
- 9. UPGRADES. To use Software identified as an upgrade, you must first be licensed for the software identified by SCOM2K7 as eligible for the upgrade. After installing the upgrade, you may no longer use the original software that formed the basis for your upgrade eligibility, except as part of the upgraded software.
- 10. NOT FOR RESALE SOFTWARE. Software identified as "Not for Resale" or "NFR," may not be sold or otherwise transferred for value, or used for any purpose other than demonstration, test or evaluation.
- 11. EXPORT RESTRICTIONS. You acknowledge that the Software is subject to U.S. export jurisdiction. - 15. LIMITED WARRANTY FOR SOFTWARE ACQUIRED IN THE US AND CANADA. SCOM2K7 warrants that the Software will perform substantially in accordance with the accompanying materials for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of receipt. If an implied warranty or condition is created by your state/jurisdiction and federal or state/provincial law prohibits disclaimer of it, you also have an implied warranty or condition, BUT

ONLY AS TO DEFECTS DISCOVERED DURING THE PERIOD OF THIS LIMITED WARRANTY (NINETY DAYS). AS TO ANY DEFECTS DISCOVERED AFTER THE NINETY DAY PERIOD, THERE IS NO WARRANTY OR CONDITION OF ANY KIND. NOT ENTITLED TO ANY DAMAGES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CONSEQUENTIAL

DAMAGES, if the Software does not meet SCOM2K7's Limited Warranty, and, to the maximum extent allowed by applicable law, even if any remedy fails of its essential purpose. The terms of Section 18 ("Exclusion of Incidental, Consequential and Certain Other Damages") are also incorporated into this Limited Warranty. Some states/jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. - 18. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND REMEDIES. Notwithstanding any damages that you might incur for any reason whatsoever (including, without limitation, all damages referenced herein and all direct or general damages in contract or anything else), the entire liability of SCOM2K7 and any of its suppliers under any provision of this EULA and your exclusive remedy hereunder (except for any remedy of repair or replacement elected by SCOM2K7 with respect to any breach of the Limited Warranty) shall be limited to the greater of the actual damages you incur in reasonable reliance on the Software up to the amount actually paid by you for the Software or US\$99.00. The foregoing limitations, exclusions and disclaimers (including Sections 16, 17 and 18) shall apply to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, even if any remedy fails its essential purpose.

20. APPLICABLE LAW. If you acquired this Software in the United States, this EULA is governed by the laws of the State of Delaware. If you acquired this Software in Canada, unless expressly prohibited by local law, this EULA is governed by the laws in force in the Province of Ontario, Canada; and, in respect of any dispute which may arise hereunder; you consent to the jurisdiction of the federal and provincial courts sitting in Toronto, Ontario. If you acquired this Software in the European Union, Iceland, Norway, or Switzerland, then local law applies. If you acquired this Software in any other country, then local law may apply.

21. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; SEVERABILITY. This EULA (including any addendum or amendment to this EULA which is included with the Software) is the entire agreement between you and SCOM2K7 relating to the Software and the support services (if any) and they supersede all prior or contemporaneous oral or written communications, proposals and representations with respect to the Software or any other subject matter covered by this EULA. To the extent the terms of any SCOM2K7 policies or programs for support services conflict with the terms of this EULA, the terms of this EULA shall control. If any provision of this EULA is held to be void, invalid, unenforceable or illegal, the other provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

The following SCOM2K7 GUARANTEE applies to you if you acquired this Software in any other country:

Statutory rights not affected - The following guarantee is not restricted to any territory and does not affect any statutory rights that you may have from your reseller or from SCOM2K7 if you acquired the Software directly from SCOM2K7.
